Back in 2014, we shared the success story of one of our favorite furry friends, Cora. She was adopted in March of 2014 after being here at Quincy Humane Society for quite some time. While her adoption day was a bittersweet day, Cora's life following was nothing short of amazing!

Once Cora made her way to her forever home, her owner stayed in contact with the staff at Quincy Humane Society to keep us up to date on the wonderful life that Cora now had! Cora settled



in and was comfortable in her new bed not too long after sniffing out her new home. She was given unconditional love and she in return loved her family unconditionally.

In May of 2016, Cora was diagnosed with diabetes and was receiving insulin injections daily. Not long after her diagnosis, she suffered from a spinal injury. She lost strength in legs and lost the ability to go up or down the stairs. While she was on restricted movement in the house, as long as she was next to her loyal companion, the pain didn't seem to bother her.
